Well done to all the children and staff for dressing up yesterday for World Book Day. Everyone looked fantastic!

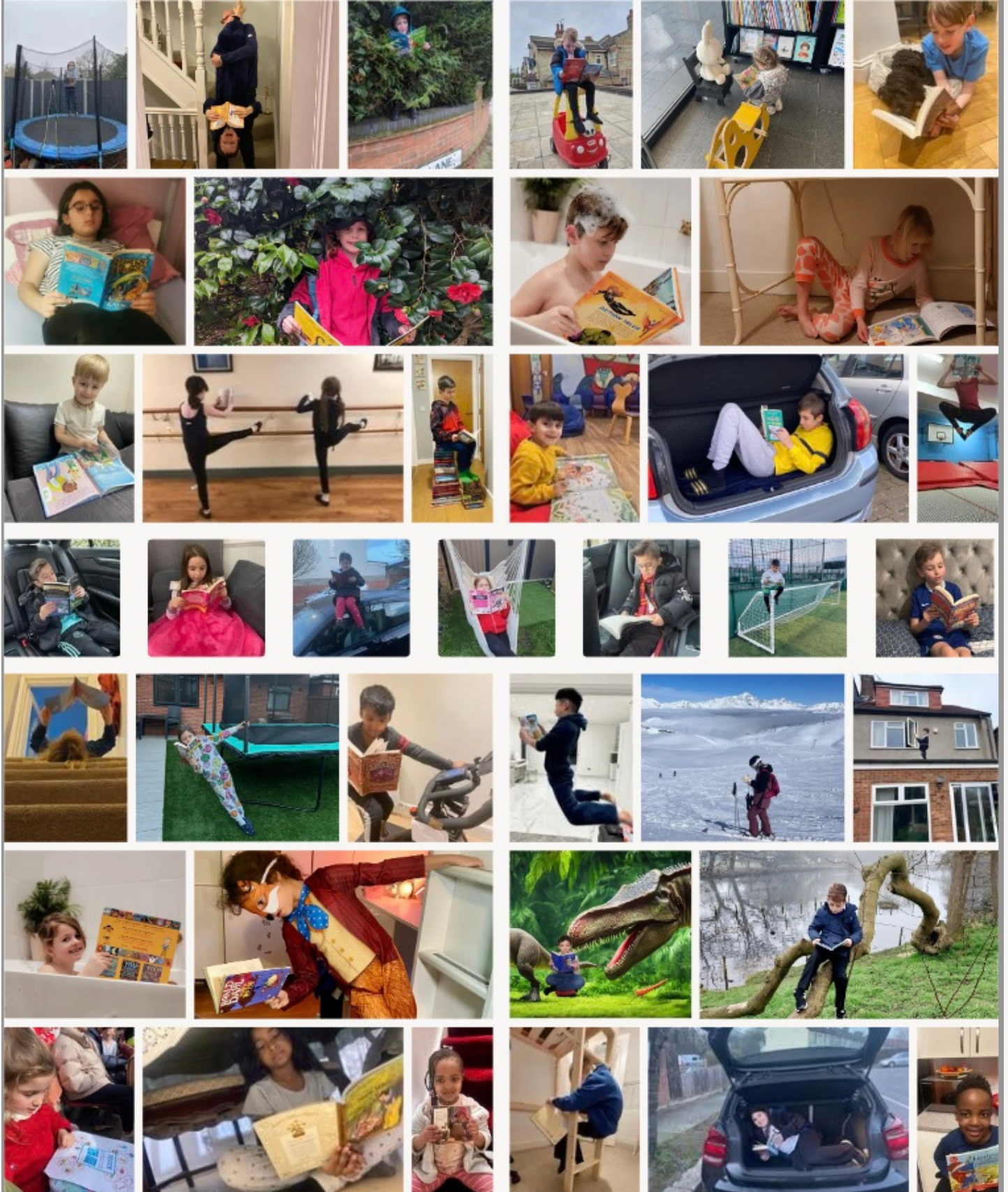
We had a great day taking part in lots of different reading/book activities and had great fun when it was time to drop everything and read.

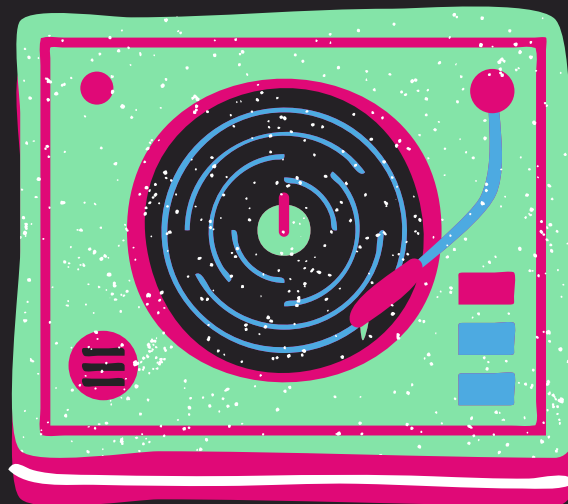
