How did you get there? Write a recount of your visit.</p>	<p>Take a trip to the park and investigate all the insects you can see. Take a picture of the insects and their habitats if possible. Write down the name of the insects you have found and describe their habitat by researching online.</p> <p>You could choose to present your research on Google slides or Google docs.</p>	<p>Watch the video <b>"Enfield 2013, Broomfield House in Palmers Green.</b> Write down all the changes that you can see from the past to present time.
