Dear Parents,

Following the recent Covid cases at Bowes, we want to share what our Remote Learning looks like should any further children or bubbles be required to isolate at home.

Remote Learning is online learning which happens at home. This work is set by the class teacher on **Google Classroom**. Once we have been informed that a child is isolating or we have closed a bubble due to Covid, Remote Learning will be available by the following day.

We have organised our Remote Learning according to three tiers which are described in more detail in the table below:

- Tier 1: Remote Learning for Individuals
- Tier 2: Remote Learning for Partial Closure (closure of a class/bubble/whole school for a short period of time, e.g. a circuit breaker)
- Tier 3: Remote Learning for Full Closure over an extended period of time (whole school)
