Booking Arrangements	- Parents can book an appointment using 'School Cloud'. - To book your appointment, please visit https://bowes.schoolcloud.co.uk/ - The platform will go live on Thursday 6th November at 7pm and will close on Friday 14th November at 5pm. - Once you have booked your time, you will then receive an email confirming the appointment. <i>*To view a short guide on how to book your appointment, please click this link. Parents should also be aware that, when you input your name and your child's name it must be exactly the same as the information we hold for you on our school system. If you need any help with making a booking, please contact the school office.</i>
Meeting Format	The meetings will be held face-to-face in school.
Meeting Location	Nursery Pupils: The meetings will be held in the main school building in one of our Reception workshops. Parents should come into school via the main gate on Highworth Road and will be directed to the meeting point by a member of staff. Reception – Year 6 Pupils: Meetings will take place in your child's classroom. There will be a waiting area outside the classroom where you can view your child's work before your appointment time.
Meeting Duration	Each appointment will be 10 minutes long . To ensure the meetings keep to time, please arrive at least 10 minutes before your appointment. Your child is very welcome to attend the meeting with you.
