Why? Who is your favourite character? Why?</p> <p><b>Suggestion:</b> Children can draw the book cover and write a sentence to match.</p> 	<p>Make some puppets of the characters from your favourite traditional tale to act out the story with your family OR make one the houses from the Three Little Pigs.</p> <p><b>Suggestion:</b> This can be made from any material and be a 2D or 3D model.</p> 	<p>Visit Buckingham Palace! Or Visit your local library and find some traditional tales.</p> <p><b>Suggestion:</b> Take photographs and add a caption to explain what you saw on your day out.</p> 	<p>Can you find and read traditional tales from around the world?</p> <p><b>Suggestion:</b> Write a book review of your favourite one.</p> 	<p>Watch 'Debbie and Friends' Traditional tales' stories on YouTube.</p>
