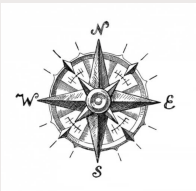
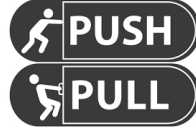
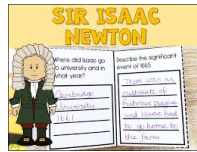


Year Three Home Learning Project

Include physical features: rivers, mountains, island, landlocked or coastal and climate: hot/tropical/polar/temperate. Write and answer some questions about the data you have presented.	Write a glossary of geographical terms. Write definitions for the following words: equator, continent, mineral, globe, physical geography and renewable resource. Challenge yourself to think of some additional words and definitions. Don't forget to list the words in alphabetical order!	Compare the physical geography of London and Yorkshire (or any rural or seaside location you may have visited). What is the physical geography of North America? Do all European countries fit into the same climate zone? Explain. You could film your discussion or make some notes about it.	Create a collage of a country in the world – choose images that represent that country. Think about food, landmarks, animals and culture. 	Visit a local park to investigate how forces work. Using the equipment on a playground such as a swing, roundabout or a slide, explore what happens when you push or pull. Make a poster illustrating your findings. 	Research the life and findings of Sir Isaac Newton, creating a fact file. 	Make a fact file based on San Francisco.
