Attendance and Punctuality

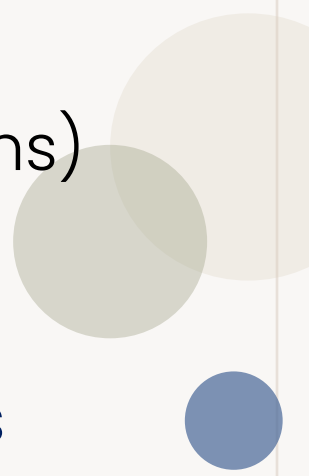
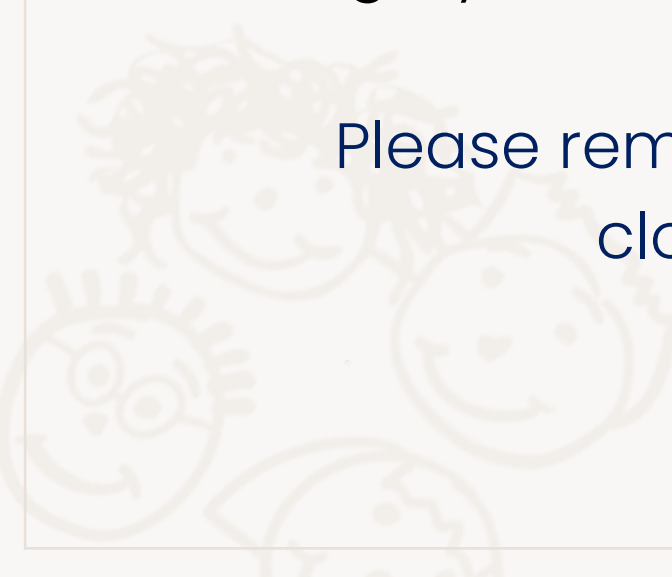
- Registration is at 8:50am

Home Learning

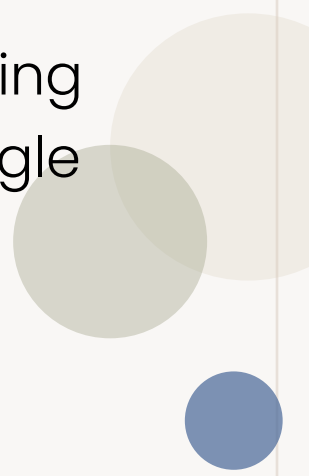
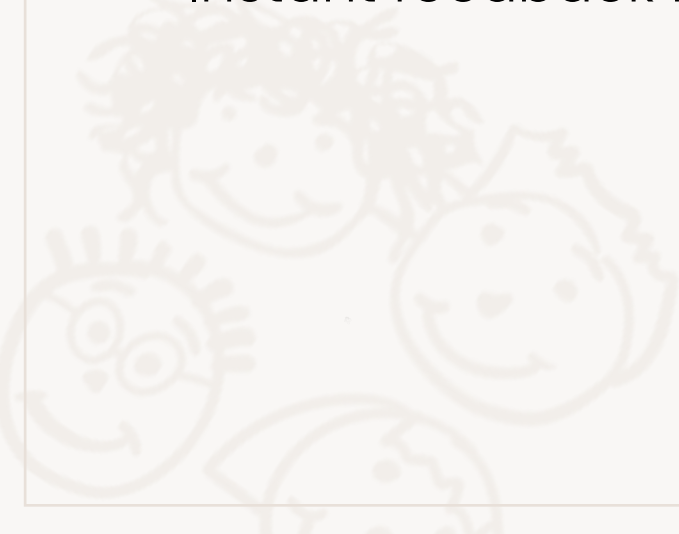


- Each child will have a Home Learning book.
- Home learning grids are sent to children each half term via Google Classroom@School and are placed in their Home Learning Book. The grids can also be found on the Bowes Website in the Classes section.
- A list of spellings will be sent out every week. These will be tested in a weekly quiz on a Friday.
- All children will have an online Read Write Inc book assigned to them each week. Once they have completed the RWI program, they will receive a variety of different books matched carefully with their phonic acquisition. Children will also have the opportunity to pick a book of their choice from their class library each week. They should read at least 10 minutes a day. Please read regularly with your child and record their progress in their reading record.
- [MyiMaths](#) homework is set weekly.

Chromebooks



- Can be used creatively
- Prepares pupils for the future
- Gives instant access to knowledge
- Encourages individual learning – personalises learning
- Team work – encourage collaboration through Google Suite
- Instant feedback for learning



Additional Chromebook Feedback



To ensure we are keeping the children safe when using their Chromebooks, we use **Senso**, a cloud-based online monitoring and safeguarding software.

Senso effectively detects harmful and inappropriate behaviour on the children's Chromebooks, both in school and at home. If the software detects inappropriate searches or the unacceptable use of language, an email is sent to the Designated Safeguarding Lead and the Senior Leadership Team. This will then be investigated and if appropriate, we will speak to the user involved and contact parents to inform them of the breach if required.

Chromebooks are for the children and should not be used by adults. The school also carries out regular internet browsing checks. 'Search history' cannot be deleted.

Chromebooks belong to the school and are loaned to the children. They must be treated with care – please refer to the signed agreement.

Do not eat or drink over the Chromebook.

It is important that the children's use of their Chromebook is monitored both at home and school. Please ensure you monitor this at home.

Year 1 Chromebooks will be distributed after the agreement has been sent and signed by the parent.

Year 1 Phonics Screening Check



- The Phonics Screening Check is a test which assesses children's level of phonics acquisition.
- There are 40 words which children are expected to be able to read accurately.
- The recent pass mark was 31.
- All Year 1 pupils will take the check week commencing 14th June 2027.

- Practise handwriting
- Little and often is best.
