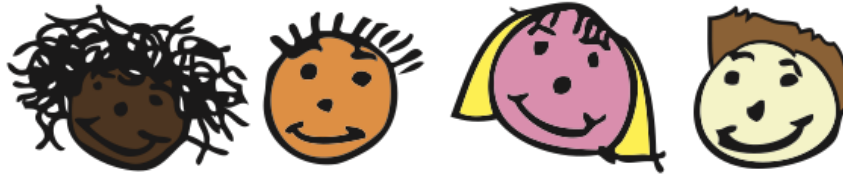

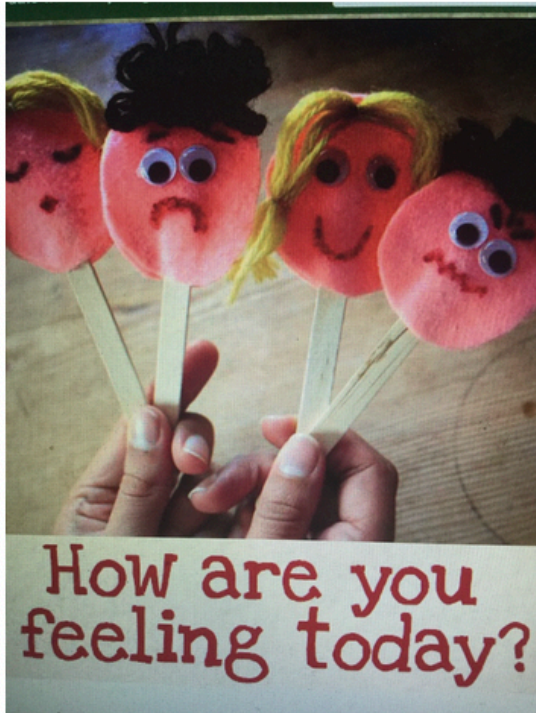
Home Learning Pack

Join in with: g o c k Play forming the letters using the rhymes on the sheet.	Phonics Look at the 4 th QR that you receive by email. Join in with u b f e Have a try at forming the letters, don't forget the 'here we go' lead-in stroke. 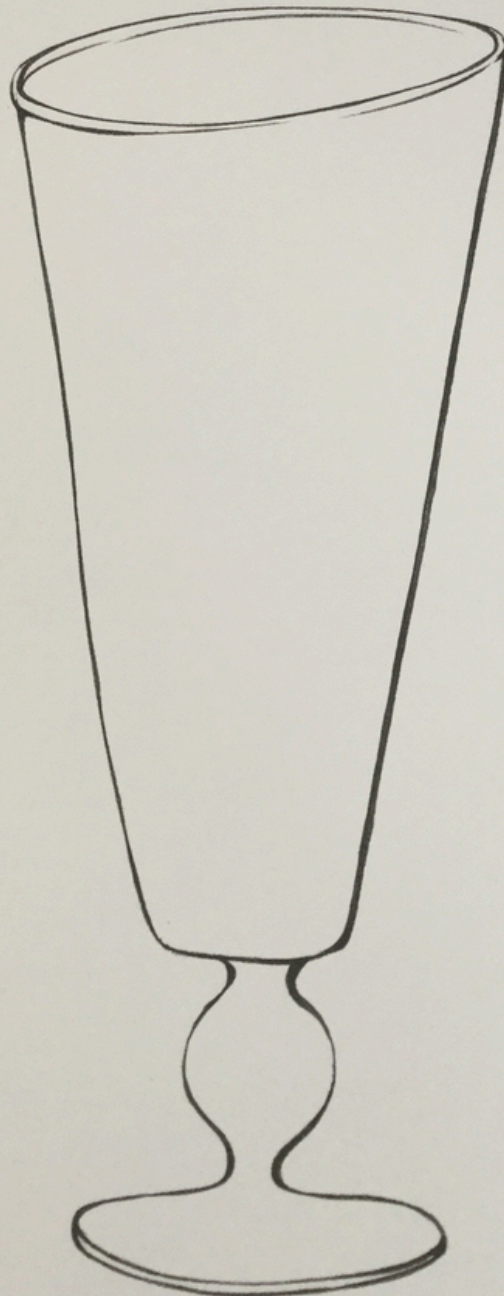
