Watch AGAIN: cbeebies Alphablocks stage 1 Episode: 'Rainbow' Read the words as the alphablocks hold hands https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/watch/alphablocks-rainbow</p>	<p>Phonics Play setting out your cards - make up some short 3 letter words by yourself - play sounding them out</p> <p>Have a try at writing some - don't forget the "here we go" lead-in stroke.</p> <p>RED WORDS: Not for sounding out: you said your Show to your child & repeat together</p>

How many hearts does Jess tell you a worm could have?</p>	<p>Expressive Arts & Design Make a String Painting Use lengths of string to dip into colourful paint - lay onto paper with 'tails' hanging off the edge - fold your paper over the top then pull the strings out - making a worm picture! <u>See attached picture.</u></p>	<p>PSED/Social & Emotional Coping with anxiety - to relax muscle tension: Turtle: Pretend you are a turtle going for a slow relaxed walk. 🐢 Oh no, it's started to rain! Curl up tight under your shell for 10 seconds. The sun's out again, come out of your shell & return to your relaxing walk. Repeat a few times, make sure to finish with a walk so that your body is relaxed.</p>
