



Stretch: nnnnnnet Handwrite: Down Nobby, over his net








Bounce: b-b-b-boot Handwrite: Down the laces to the heel, round the toe

Bounce: k-k-k-k-angaroo Handwrite: Down the kangaroo's body, tail and leg




Bounce: c-c-c-caterpillar Handwrite: Curl around the caterpillar

Bounce: 0-0-0-orange Handwrite: All around the orange




Bounce: h-h-h-h-horse Handwrite: Down the head to the hooves and over his back





Stretch: IIIIlleg Handwrite: Down the long leg










Bounce: e-e-e-egg Handwrite: Lift off the top and scoop out the egg









