Topic	Geography/History Learning Focus – To show how trains have changed over time. Learn – Look at the 'History of trains' powerpoint pictures and read the captions with help if you need. Practise – Look at the pictures of trains on and sort trains from oldest to newest on the timeline. (Click and drag to sort the pictures or number the pictures in your home learning book or google classroom.) Review – Check the answers. How well did I do?	Science Learning Focus - Follow a method and perform a simple test to create a rainbow. I can observe closely and record what I see. Learn – Set up your experiment after listening carefully to the method in the recording. Practise – Become a scientist and carry out the experiment, following each step carefully. Review – What happened? Ask a grownup to take a photograph of what you see during your rainbow experiment or draw a picture of your findings.Read the 'Where did the rainbow come from.'
