




# Year One Home Learning Project

Where did you visit? What did you see? How did you feel?</p>	<p>beach cliff sea ocean coast soil</p> <p>Discuss what each of the words above mean. Can you draw a picture of some of them?</p> <p>What is the difference between a sea and an ocean?</p> 	<p>Create your own flavour of ice cream</p> <p><b>or</b></p> <p>Create a collage or a picture to show the different seasons and how the weather changes in each season.</p> <p>Show your work to an adult and let them guess which season is which. Here's an example:</p> 	<p>Teach an adult how to count from any number in tens. Then use the internet to find out how much each of these items would cost.</p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> Do they have all items available? How much does the shop come to? Do all stores sell the items at the same price?</p> 	<p>Research seasons in other countries.
