My day at school

	<p>Welcome back to Bowes!</p> <p>We understand that you will have lots of questions about coming back to school.</p> <p>You might have a different teacher and a new classroom but your teachers are looking forward to working with you and will be able to answer any questions you have. Your classroom will look different, this is to make sure you are all as safe as possible.</p> <p>There will be some new things for you to remember too, like staying 2 metres apart from other children and your teachers. You now get to have your very own desk and own equipment. This belongs to you and you must not share these with anyone else and it must stay at school.</p> <p>We know that you might be feeling a bit excited or even a bit anxious and school will be different to what you are used to but this is so we can stay as safe as possible.</p>
<p>When I get to school</p> <p>Bowes Primary School</p> 	<p>I will need to arrive at school on time and enter the playground with my grown up.</p> <p>My teacher will be there to meet me in a designated zone.</p> <p>When I go inside, I will wash my hands for 20 seconds and then go to my new classroom. If I have a packed lunch and a water bottle with me, I will need to place this in my locker.</p> <p>I will find my desk. This is now my desk when I am at school.</p> <p>At my desk, I will have everything I need to do my work. These items are for me to use and I do not need to share. I will receive an A4 wallet containing a pen, pencil, ruler, rubber and pencil sharpener. The clear, plastic wallet can be easily wiped down. I will try and keep it clean every day!</p>
<p>Register</p> 	<p>My teacher will take the register.</p>
<p>Session 1</p> 	<p>Maths</p> <p>I will work on my numbers, shapes and do some problem solving.</p> <p>I will complete this at my table.</p>

<p>Session 2</p> 	<p>Phonics/Spelling</p> <p>We will have phonics time.</p>
<p>Playtime</p> 	<p>At playtime, my teacher will take us out to play in our designated playground.</p> <p>We will stay together and not mix with any other classes who maybe out playing in their designated playground.</p> <p>When we play, we need to try and keep some distance between us.</p> <p>At the end of playtime, my teacher will lead us back in and we will all wash our hands again.</p>
<p>Session 3</p> 	<p>Writing</p> <p>I will use my phonics to read, write key words, label my drawings and write sentences.</p> <p>I will complete this at my table.</p>
<p>Session 4</p> 	<p>Learning Quest</p> <p>I will do some creative learning. I might paint, draw or make a model using a variety of materials.</p>
<p>Story time</p> 	<p>My teacher will read a story.</p>
<p>Home time</p> 	<p>At the end of the school day, my teacher will lead me out to the playground to meet my grown-up.</p> <p>I need to remember to keep apart from my classmates when leaving the playground.</p>

Hand washing and Hygiene

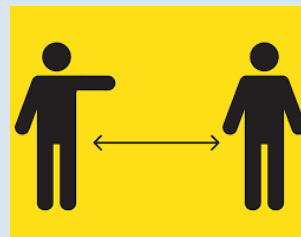
You will be expected to follow all hand washing and hygiene routines while in school. You will wash hands /use antibacterial gel before entering school, after returning from the outside, before and after eating and at regular intervals during the day.



If you do cough or sneeze, you should use your hand or elbow to cover your mouth. You will be asked to use a tissue and throw it away. You will then need to wash your hands for at least 20 seconds. Please try and remember not to touch your face, mouth, nose or eyes while at school. We will keep reminding you as well.
