Enrichment Clubs – Frequently Asked

Question	Answer
Can I choose more than 1 club for my child?	Yes
Am I guaranteed a place from at least one club?	We are not able to guarantee a place for your child, as it will depend on the demand for places.
Where will my child get changed for a physical activity club?	The children will get changed in an allocated classroom, which will be shared with the children before they start.
Where do I collect my child at the end of their enrichment club?	When you come to collect your child, please enter the school through the main gate (the single gate on Highworth Road), which leads up to the office. Please wait in the gated area for your child. All the children will be dismissed from the front door. Adults are not permitted to enter the building when collecting their child/ren.
Can I pay weekly?	Like most external after school clubs payment must be paid in advance, in full. Payment details will be given to parents at the point of offering places.
What safeguarding practices are in place?	All staff, for both internal and external clubs hold an Enhanced DBS (A Criminal Record Check at Enhanced Disclosure level) and are trained in safeguarding.
Will all staff running the clubs be first aid trained?	No, but there will be at least one member of After School Club staff who is First Aid trained, should a child need medical attention.
Can my child still attend the Bowes After School Club provision after they have attended an enrichment club?	Yes, once your child has finished their club, they will be escorted to the After School Club and the Managers will be informed.
What will my child need to wear for enrichment clubs?	This depends on the type of club they are attending. Sports clubs require the Active Uniform; all other clubs require school uniform. If any other clothing is necessary for some activities, parents will be made aware of this by the person running the club.
Will my child need a snack or a drink?	Your child should take their bottle of water (named) with them and refill as necessary.
How will I know that my child has gone to their after school enrichment club?	Your child's Class Teacher will know what day(s) your child will be attending an enrichment club and will ensure they get there each week. Please do remind your child on the day(s) they are attending a club, as sometimes the younger ones do forget.
What if my child is absent on that day?	The class teacher will ensure that the person running the club knows if a child is absent. Also, the person running the club will double check with the school office if a child is absent that they did not know about.
Can I get a refund if my child is unable to attend the club?	Once sessions have been booked and paid for, we are unable to offer any refunds.
Are Pupil Premium children entitled to attend a free enrichment club?	Pupil Premium children are entitled to attend one free club at some point in the year.
