KEEPING CHILDREN SAFE

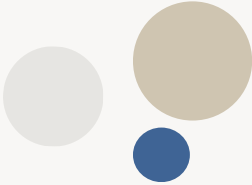

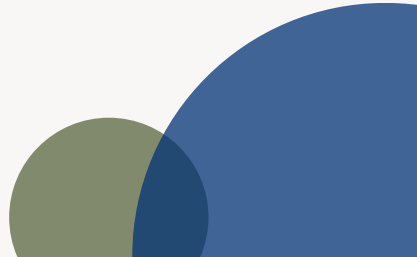
